



ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA – 2nd ANNUAL EXAMINATION 2023

NOTE: Part I students appeared in 1st Annual Exam 2023 are NOT eligible to appear in 2nd Annual Exam 2023

1. Grade IX

- **Regular:** Students completed their Grade 8 in 2022 or before are eligible to appear in Regular Grade IX with age limit (minimum 12 years, maximum 20 years).
- **Private:** Any fresh student (at least 12 years old) may appear in IX Private with the basic document requirements.

2. Grade X

Students who have passed their Grade IX Examination **not before 2020** from ZUEB or other board may appear in Grade X.

3. Grade XI

- Students who have passed their Grade X Examination in 2022 or within the last 5 years (**not before 2018**) may appear in Grade XI.
- Students having gap of more than 5 years may appear as a private candidate.

4. Grade XII

Students who have passed their Grade XI Examination **not before 2020** from ZUEB or other board may appear in Grade XII.

5. Improvement

- Any student, having passed SSC/HSC Examination (Part I & II) **not before 2020**, is eligible to appear for improvement of grade/marks.
- Students may appear in all subjects of Part I / Part II / Part I & II Combined for improvement.
- Students may appear in subject pairs (of both Parts) for improvement, maximum three subject pairs allowed.

P.S. Best Marks (either current or previous) will be awarded to students on Improvement Marksheet.

6. Additional

Any student, having passed SSC/HSC Examination (Part I & II) **not before 2020**, may appear for additional subjects with the basic subject requirements.

7. Failure / Supplementary / Absentees

- ZUEB students who failed in Part I / Part II Examination **not before 2020** may appear in the failed subject(s).
- Other board students who failed in Part I / Part II Examination **not before 2020** may appear in Part I & II Combined Examination.



Note

- Enrolment form will NOT be accepted without B-form/CNIC.
- Student's enrolment is valid for four consecutive years. If enrolment has expired, a student needs to apply for fresh enrolment.
- Other board students must attach authentic Migration Certificate.
- ZUEB permission/voucher will be required for each of the following categories:
 - Change of Board
 - Change of School
 - Additional Subjects
 - Improvement of Grade
- ZUEB reserves the right to CANCEL any student's enrolment form if school fails to rectify the Board's objection in three attempts (no refund will be made).
